
GPS Track Recording

Why should you bother to record and share your race track?


- Share your race with crew and family.

GPS track recording Instructions

- Set the Smartphone to never sleep.
 - iPhone Settings -- -- -- -> General -- -- -- > Auto-- Lock -- -- -- -> Never
 - Android phone: Run an App (<u>Redeye</u>) to stop the phone from sleeping.
- Turn on Location Service using GPS
 - iPhone Settings -- -- -- > Privacy -- -- ! Location services -- -- -- > ON
 - Android phone: Settings -----> Location---> Mode ---> Device only
- Go to www.jibeset.net
- Click "Record a GPS track"
- Display the recording Login screen
- Enter Sail Number and Password
 - Click "Login Next Race only"
 - Displays your next scheduled race
 - If this is the one you want, click "Race ..."
- If this is not the one you want
 - Enter Sail number and Password, click Login All future races"
 - Displays a list of all future race
 - Click 'Race ..." for the race you want
- Displays the recording screen
 - Check that the time is correct
- Wait for the "Is it OK to use current location" questions
 - Click "Allow" {or whatever you phone's question is}
- Plug Smart Phone into a charger {GPS uses a lot of power}
- To start recording, click "START Recording"
- You should see:
 - Recorded data in the center of the screen
 - Count of the number of points recorded red number at the top
 - Green / Orange color changes around "Recording and the time"
- To stop recording, click "STOP Recording"
- When the race is over and you have a "WiFi" connection
 - Click "UPLOAD to Jibeset
 - Track will appear in a Google Map display.

Android setup


- Locate Redeye in Google play by searching for "redeye stay awake" or use this link

 Once installed the app can be toggled on and off. When toggled "Off" your phone works as it always has. When it is toggled "On" the phone does not sleep and the GPS keeps recording.


Android Setup

- Turn your phone to GPS only by selecting "Settings"
